## **Mayor James Eves- Sewer Treatment Plant**

Letters sent prior to Redi meeting to FEMA, Jefferson County Planning, O'Brien Gere Engineers, NYS Homeland Security, and Fourth Coast, requesting an onsite review and additional funds of \$2,000,000. for the 2019 high water damage to Sewer tank property erosion, and additional \$500,000 for the boat launch erosion.

The Mayor attended a REDI meeting with the Jefferson County and St Lawrence Planning team Friday July 12<sup>th</sup>. At the meeting FEMA advised not applying for any of the \$300,000,000. from New York State. It would be better to re-evaluate the damages and apply for additional funds through FEMA.
